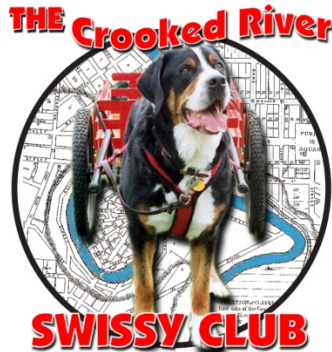

## Everybody's least favorite topic.....COVID

We are all trying to get back to normal, but the event will look different this year.

- 1) Every person attending the event (including people who are accompanying a dog handler or people who are just coming to visit and have no dogs entered) **must sign the COVID- 19 Waiver plus the General Liabilities Release** to gain access to the site of the SwissAthlon. The form must be signed by hand, electronic signatures not accepted.
- 2) We have re-designed the event to have lower density and be entirely outdoors. **Social distancing (6 feet) will be required**, and that will make it possible to have masks not be required when distance can be maintained.
- 3) Entrants are **encouraged to wear masks** as appropriate for your comfort level and your individual risk factors or vaccination status to help us maintain a safe event.
- 4) Everyone needs to bring a mask as there are a few portions of the event that require close exposure to another person (draft equipment check, notifying for weight pull passes etc). The judge may ask you to wear a mask in these situations.
- 5) There will be a lot of shared touch points which are unrealistic to clean between each use, so please use hand sanitizer often.
- 6) We love all the Swissies, but don't touch other people's dogs without permission.
- 7) Do not enter the Fralick's home unless authorized
- 8) Don't come to the event if you are not feeling well or have any symptoms consistent with Covid, have been exposed to Covid within 14 days or if your home region is experiencing an outbreak.
- 9) We will be re-evaluating the Covid situation closer to the event date, implementing guidance from AKC, Ohio guidelines for large gatherings, Franklin County Ohio Department of Health, CDC, and other state and local recommendations. Any changes from the above guidelines will be distributed on the Crooked River Website and Facebook and posted at the event.
- 10) The CRSC reserves the option to cancel the event entirely.

You will receive a full refund for entries, food and lodging if you need to skip attending due to Covid (illness of yourself or a family member, quarantining after a potential exposure or living in an area with a current outbreak) or for any aspect of the event that the CRSC cancels.

## **Event changes for this year:**

- 1) The event has been overhauled to promote maintaining social distance even as we focus on the enjoyment of the working events and a chance to be back together.
- 2) We are not going to have some of the additional offerings that usually are a part of the weekend. The raffle, silent auction, ways and means and puppy match will all be skipped this year.
- 3) We will only serve box lunches at the event. Breakfasts and dinners will be on your own.
- 4) There will not be a central tent. Please bring your own pop- up tent or other methods of creating shade for yourself and your dogs. Also bring chairs or a picnic blanket for eating lunch.
- 5) The weight pull will require advance entry, and you will hook your own dog.

## **A couple facility changes:**

- 1) The weight pull will be held in a new location, under an overhang along the back side of the wooden barn (location of the draft trial).
- 2) The configuration around the front barn has changed so now there are very few electric connections, and you will need an extremely long extension cord to access it. Electric access is first come, first served.

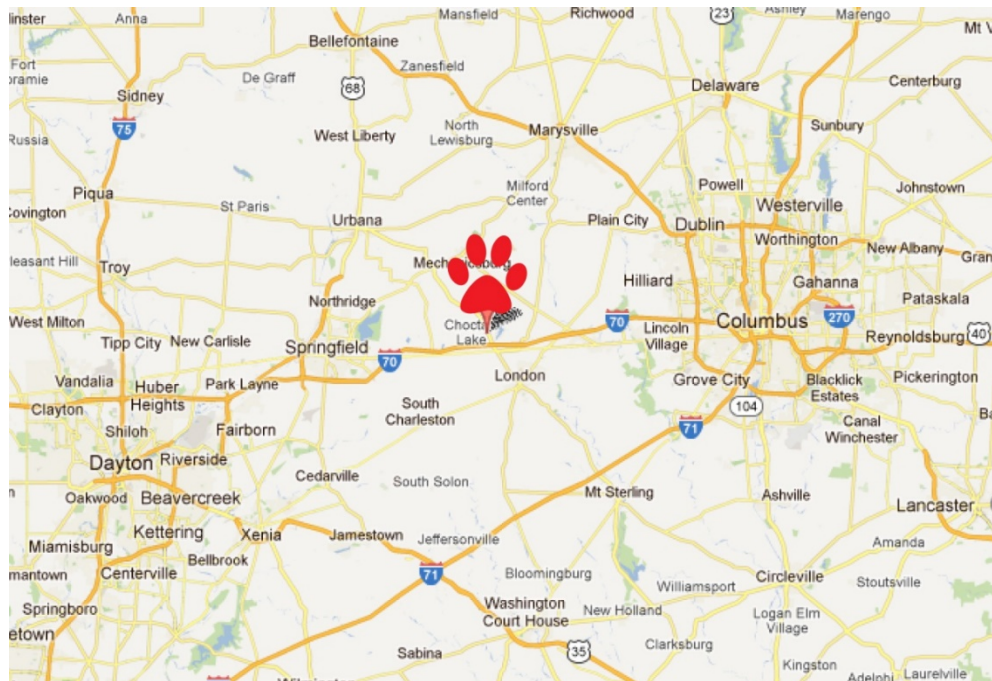
**NOTE: GPS tends to be inaccurate to this address. If you pass a prison after getting off the freeway, you are going the wrong direction.**

- Turn right onto **OH-56 W/W Urbana-London Rd**
- House is 1.3 miles on left



## LODGING

Dawn and Bob Fralick invite you to stay on their beautiful farm to best enjoy all the events and experiences of the SwissAthlon. There is tons of room to set up a tent or RV...you can choose to camp close to the action or set yourself apart a ways and enjoy the peace and quiet of the countryside.

We are asking a lodging fee of \$25/campsite for the weekend, which goes to the CRSC to help cover the cost of the event. We do **require pre-registration** for staying on-site – please indicate on the ‘Events Summary & Sign-Up’ page if you plan on lodging at the Fralicks and make sure to submit by the registration deadline.

**There will be a limited number (even more limited than previous years) of electrical hook-ups available on a first come, first served basis.** The layout around the front barn has changed, so you will need an extremely long cord to access the power.

You can set-up starting at 3 p.m. on Thursday, October 14<sup>th</sup>. Please plan to pull in no later than 8:00 in the evening on your day of arrival.

The Fralicks are offering use of their bathroom and shower facilities, found in the heated garage, for those staying on site. You will need to supply your own towels and toiletries.

**For those of you who do not want to camp**, we recommend hotels at exit 91 (Hilliard-Rome Road) at the outskirts of Columbus. Here you will find a large selection of hotels from most of the major chains. Options include:

Please note: There is an all breed show nearby at the Champaign County Fairgrounds, hosted by the Mad River Valley Kennel Club on Saturday and Sunday. The schedule of the SwissAthlon will not permit flexibility based on ring times at the conformation show, so please keep that in mind if you plan to move between both events.

## **PACK HIKES**

### **Course Descriptions:**

#### **Saturday, October 16<sup>th</sup> – Prairie Oaks Metro Park Hike**

Hikers will meet up at the Fralick farm weight pull barn at 8:00am for weigh in then entrants will drive to the Prairie Oaks Metro Park (about a 15 minute trip). There will be an 8 mile hike weaving through the fields, woods, and around the ponds at the Prairie Oaks Metro Park for all those hikers planning on doing both Saturday & Sunday's hikes (no extension to 10 miles is available today).

#### **Sunday, October 17<sup>th</sup> – Fralick Farm Hike**

This hike will explore the Fralick farm after weighing in at 8:00am Sunday. There will be an 8 mile hike touring through the 100+ acre property for all those hikers completing their second hike, and an additional 2 mile leg will be available for hikers who are doing just this one hike. There will be chances for the dogs to jump in a pond to cool off and at least half the hike will take place in the shade.

### **Administrative Details:**

#### **Pre-entry is required.**

The Pack Dog Hikes will be conducted per the GSMDCA Pack Dog Rules. All GSMD's over 18 month the day of the hike are eligible for Working Pack Dog Titles. Non-Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs are eligible to participate in GSMDCA pack dog hikes. Bitches in season are not allowed to participate.

First and foremost, hikes are to be conducted with the safety and well-being of the canine and human participants in mind. The Hike Coordinator is authorized to make any necessary decisions to protect the health and safety of the dogs and handlers.

Dogs must complete both Saturday & Sunday 8 mile hikes to receive two legs toward their pack dog title. The 10 mile hike on Sunday will receive one pack dog leg.

Only one dog per handler is allowed if hiking for a pack dog leg.

No weight certificate needed – we will take dog weights and pack weights the mornings of the hikes.

Make sure to have adequate flea & tick protection because this is a bad time of year for ticks!

#### **Entry Fees**

Entry fees for the pack dog hikes are \$30.00 per dog if entered both days OR \$20.00 per dog for a Sunday only. If you want to enter the pack dog hikes, please mark your preferred event on the "Events Summary and Sign Up Page" then complete a "Consolidated Entry Form" and a "Working Pack Hike Event Handler Entry Form" for each dog.

All entrants will receive a participatory prize.

## WEIGHT PULLS

Friday, October 15<sup>th</sup> & Saturday, October 16<sup>th</sup>

**Please note: this year Pre-entry is required.**

**Also note: there will not be a hooker in the chute. Please plan to hook your own dog and manage your own leash**

Two weight pull competitions under GSMDCA rules are featured during the SwissAthlon weekend. The event will take place on Friday early afternoon following the membership meeting after the draft trial and Saturday mid afternoon following the draft trial/ pack hike.

The format is wheels on carpet. We will have extra weight pull harnesses available for those who do not yet own one.

Craig Fields will be our judge.

Prizes will be awarded to the dogs who achieve

- Most Weight Pulled
- Most Weight Pulled Per Body Pound

Dogs pulling 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th place in their respective weight classes will receive a ribbon.

Weight classes are as follows:

- Under 90 pounds
- 90 to 109 pounds
- 110 to 129 pounds
- 130 and over pounds

Entries should be submitted on the SwissAthlon "Consolidated Entry Form".

The fee is \$20.00/dog to enter your dog each day in the weight pull

Each day will contain two draft trials which will be run one after the other. A team can only enter one test. Assignment to the trials will be performed by the Draft Test Secretary with first priority to avoid conflict of interest with the judging panel based on shared ownership, then to minimize handler conflicts with multiple dogs, then to balance the trials.

Trial #1 will begin at 8:00 AM each day, completing all 3 phases of that trial, then Trial #2 will immediately follow. Remember that each trial starts with the Equipment Check, requiring that the dog be hitched to the cart with your freight haul weight in place.

**Entries close at 5:00 PM, Friday October 1, 2021** at the address below, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or altered, except as specifically allowed in the GSMDCA Draft Test Regulations. The entry fee is \$30.00 per single dog team and \$30.00 per brace team. ## ENTRY INFORMATION

**Definitions:** The term dog applies to dogs of both sexes. The term team means a handler and his/her dog. All terms and instructions and regulations that refer to a single dog also apply to a pair of dogs working together unless otherwise noted.

### Important Details:

1. Entered dogs must be 18 months or older on the day of the Draft Test.
2. Entry is limited to 15 teams total, regardless of class entered. If there are fewer than 3 entries, the test will not be held. If more than 15 entries are received, a random drawing will be held within 48 hours of the closing time. Alternates will also be drawn and may compete in the absence of regular entries. All entrants will be notified by e-mail of their entry status no later than five days prior to the test date.
3. Non Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs are welcome to enter this test, although GSMDs will be given preference over other breeds in a situation where the test maximum entry is met. Untitled teams have preference over titled teams, where 'title' means the title of the entered class. In the case of a brace, both dogs must be titled to be considered a titled team.
4. Bitches in season will not be permitted to compete at this test. Entry fees shall be refunded upon receipt of a veterinary certificate stating an entered bitch is in season at the time of the Draft Test.
5. The Basic Control Exercise shall be waived for dogs that have earned a CD title **IF** a copy of the CD title certificate is sent with the entry form. For Brace Class entries, both dogs must have earned their CDs in order to waive Basic Control.
6. Handlers must provide the draft rig and weight for the freight haul. Any of the following draft rigs may be used: cart, wagon, sled, toboggan, or travois. Each of these must be equipped so that the draft rig cannot run up on the dog when hauling downhill.
7. Entrants are responsible for obtaining the current GSMDCA Draft Test Regulations and being familiar with them. The rules are available on the GSMDCA website under Working Activities then select Drafting.

### Prizes

All entrants will receive a ring prize, and each dog with a passing performance will receive a qualifiers gift.

### The Test Site

The maneuver course will be held in a fenced field on-site at the Fralick farm. The Freight Haul course consists of a 1 mile trek primarily along cleared paths through fields and woods. There are at least 3 different surfaces (grass, gravel, and dirt) and a gradual down/upslope where the trail moves around the pond.

I will follow the American Kennel Club and Greater Swiss Mountain Dog Club of America requirements, procedures, protocols and guidelines to help reduce any exposure to or risk from spreading COVID- 19 or any other Communicable Disease. In consideration for and as a condition to the undersigned being permitted to enter and participate in the “Event”, the undersigned on his or her behalf of his or her heirs, legal representatives, and assigns (collectively hereinafter referred to as the “Undersigned”) hereby RELEASES, WAIVES, AND DISCHARGES the “Club” and their respective heirs, legal representatives, officers, employees, agents, assigns and affiliates, as appropriate (such parties, together with the “Club”, hereinafter collectively referred to as the “Released Parties”), from any and all liability, claims, demands, or causes of action that the Undersigned may have now and hereafter for any and all injuries to his or her person or property and for damages, including but not limited to, those injuries or damages CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASED PARTIES while the Undersigned is on the site of the SwissAthlon, for any purpose or participation in any activity whatsoever. The Undersigned hereby EXPRESSLY AGREES he or she WILL NOT SUE OR MAKE A CLAIM against the Released Parties for damages or other losses sustained as a result of his or her presence on or participation in any activity on such property. The Undersigned further AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Released Parties and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost that the Released Parties may incur due to the presence of the Undersigned on the property of Owner, including, without limitation, subrogation and/or derivative claims brought by any third party or insurer in connection with any injury or damage the Undersigned may incur while on the property of Owner, including the pond. The Undersigned AFFIRMS he or she is covered under appropriate general liability and personal health insurance policies issued through a licensed insurance carrier. The Undersigned EXPRESSLY ACKNOWLEDGES, AGREES, AND UNDERSTANDS his or her presence and participation in activities on the property have inherent risks and dangers no amount of care, caution, instruction, or expertise can eliminate these risks and dangers, and he or she EXPRESSLY AND VOLUNTARILY ASSUMES ALL RISK OF DEATH OR PERSONAL INJURY SUSTAINED WHILE PARTICIPATING IN SUCH ACTIVITIES ON THE PROPERTY WHETHER OR NOT CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASED PARTIES. The Undersigned further EXPRESSLY AGREES the foregoing release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State in which the activities are conducted and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding continue in full legal force. THE UNDERSIGNED HAS READ AND VOLUNTARILY SIGNS THE RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND CLAIMS, AND UNDERSTANDS THAT HE OR SHE HAS GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT, ASSURANCE, OR GUARANTEE BEING MADE TO HIM OR HER, AND INTENDS THAT HIS OR HER SIGNATURE IS A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY OF THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW. The Undersigned further AGREES that no oral representations, statements, or inducements apart from the foregoing written agreement have been made.

I personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim. I agree to be responsible for any loss and expense (including legal fees) incurred by any of the listed parties based on claims related in any way to my participation or the actions of the dog in relationship to this event, whether the claims are made by third parties or by myself. Additionally, I agree to assume the sole responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury (including death) to myself or to the dog in relationship to this event. I agree to RELEASE, INDEMNIFY and promise not to sue the parties listed above for any such loss, damage or injury to myself or the dog, regardless of the cause, and whether or not the loss, damage or injury may have been caused by the negligence of the listed parties. I AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION.
